## Description

A fine example of an early 20th-century hickory-shafted Diamond Back Cleek, made by the renowned St Andrews clubmaker David Anderson & Sons.

The club features the distinctive Diamond Back design, with circular hand-punched face markings and an original leather grip. Popular with both professional and amateur golfers in the early 1900s, the Diamond Back pattern was designed to concentrate additional weight directly behind the sweet spot, helping to produce a solid and consistent strike.

This is an attractive and authentic period club, presented in good, playable condition, with the original hickory shaft and leather grip adding to its historic character and appeal.
