Description

Antique Mahogany Golf Ball Display Cabinet.

A Victorian wall display cabinet with a display of 39 original vintage golf balls. The cabinet is with a single lockable glazed door and a faux red leather background. The balls sit on individually turned wooden display stands. The glass door gives a clear view of each and every golf ball on display, whilst helping to protect the balls from dust and damage. The thirty-nine balls are sold with the cabinet and range from 1890's gutty ball to 1960's Dunlop 65. It is a good varied selection of gutta-percha, rubber core, mesh, bramble and dimple golf balls.

The list of balls from top to bottom, left to right, are:-

Top shelf/ 1890's solid mesh gutty, 1900 bramble Spring Vale Hawk, 1900 bramble Goodyear 'The Arrow', A very good example of a rare 'The Opresto' bramble patterned gutty ball by Halley & Co., 1905 rubber core bramble 'Special Flyer'.

2/ 1900 small gutta percha ball, 1890's well used solid mesh pattern gutty golf ball (most of the paint has gone), 1895 well used Silvertown gutta percha mesh pattern ball, 1890 exceptional gutta percha golf ball in mint original condition, 1910 bramble pattern rubber core golf ball, manufactured by Helsby Company (British Insulated & Helsby Cable, Ltd.) Helsby, Warrington, England, 1910 Large NOVA Floater bramble ball, 1900 Springvale 27 ½ gutty bramble ball.

3/ 1900 Springvale 27 ½ gutty bramble ball, 1910 St. Mungo 'Heavy Colonel' bramble pattern ball, 1920's mesh patterned 'X L Challenger' golf ball, 1920's unusual mesh pattern 'Clincher Cross 31' ball, 1930's mesh or lattice pattern 'Blue - Flash' number 5.

4 / 'Rothmans 1' mesh or lattice pattern ball, mesh or lattice 'Black & White Colonel', 1920's mint condition remould Spalding 'Kro-Flite' mesh pattern ball, 1920's unusual mesh pattern 'The Ocobo' ball, 1925 'Spalding Triangle' mesh pattern golf ball, 1920's "Why Not" unusual circle, trellis pattern ball.

5/ 1915 mesh patterned 'B.I.' ball with part paper cover, 1910 mesh and dimple pattern 'Warwick' ball, 1930's unnamed mesh or lattice pattern ball, 1920's 'Lynx' mesh, lattice pattern golf ball, 1930's Cochrane's Two Five lattice pattern golf ball.

6/ 1920's Pin Hi mesh pattern golf ball, stamped Pin Hi & Scotland, 1950's Dunlop no.2 mesh pattern golf ball, Bonny Doon mesh / lattice pattern golf ball, 1960's Dunlop 65 dimple golf ball, 1960's yellow coloured dimple pattern golf ball.

Bottom shelf/ 1960's Dunlop 65 dimple golf ball in original wrapper, 1960's 'Lynx' No. 1 dimple pattern golf ball, 1980's No. 8 Slazenger Red Cross, 1913 Black Silver King dot mesh No.3 ball in original wrapper, 1970's Slazenger 27.9 No. 1 dimple pattern ball, 1940's GBD No. 2 Penfold dimple golf ball, 1960's Dunlop 65 No.4 golf ball in original wrapper.
