Description

Signed Ernest Greenwood Wentworth Golf Club Print.

This fine aquatint after Ernest Greenwood depicts the renowned Wentworth Golf Club, with a view looking towards the 18th Green and the clubhouse on the East Course. Signed by the artist in the left-hand margin, it forms part of a celebrated series of golf course aquatints published by Fores Ltd during the 1950s.

Aquatint is an intaglio printmaking technique closely related to etching. Unlike traditional etching, which relies primarily on lines, aquatint uses acid to produce subtle tonal variations and rich textures, giving the finished image the soft, atmospheric quality of a watercolour painting.

Beautifully framed and preserved in excellent condition, this print captures one of Britain's most prestigious and historic golf courses with remarkable elegance. It is titled Wentworth, Looking Towards the 18th Green - East Course and was published in May 1954 by Fores Ltd, 123 New Bond Street, London W1. Copyright was registered in all countries, including the United States, and the print is credited to Ernest Greenwood and Lawrence Josset.
