The All-England Series By H.S.C. Everard GOLF - Golf In Theory And Practice (some hints to beginners), two copies one published in 1904 the other 1910 (first edition was published in 1897). Both hard back copies with pictorial cloth cover, one blue and one green, 194 pages and illustrated throughout. The 1904 copy with advertisements, F.H. Ayres, A.W. Gamage Ltd., Ransomes' lawn Mowers, E. Brown & Son's boot preparations, Flor De Dindigul cigars, Lambert goldsmiths, Shanks's Golf Mowers, Carters grass seeds, G. Forrester & Son golf club and ball maker, John Piggott golfing requisites, Boulton & Paul Ltd. and The Royal Forest Hotel - Epping Forest.

Golf Clubs & How To Use Them by Edward Ray. Hard back copy, third edition - 1926. Instructional book on playing golf. The author states his own set of clubs as four wooden clubs, a cleek, a driving iron, an iron, a mashie, a niblick and a putter.

The Golf Swing by Burnham Hare - The Golfing Swing simplified and its mechanism correctly explained. Hard back copy. sixth edition - 1922, colourful cover. Instructional book on playing golf.
