These evocative game bird scenes contrast the tranquillity and intensity of the Scottish Moors across two consecutive days:

"Peace" depicts the serene moors on 11th August, the day before the grouse shooting season begins. "War" captures the same landscape on 12th August, the opening day of the season, alive with activity and energy.
