The eagles are positioned against a hand-painted backdrop, with a convincingly modelled rocky cliff environment enhanced by carefully arranged foliage, creating a vivid sense of habitat and depth.

The composition exemplifies the high standards and artistry associated with one of the most respected families of 19th-century taxidermists. The case retains its original paper trade label, inscribed: "HENRY WARD, (Late Williams), 2 Vere St. Oxford St. London," adding both authenticity and historical interest.
